FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed at a rate of 3.0 lbs per head per day to provide 350 mg/head/day of Chlortetracycline. Always provide plenty of fresh, clean water for drinking. Keep feed fresh in cool, dry storage. DO NOT use feed that is old, molded or insect contaminated.

WARNING: Withdrawal times vary by manufacturer. Read the label for specific withdrawal times. A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in pre-ruminating calves. DO NOT USE IN CALVES TO BE PROCESSED FOR VEAL.
